3. Participation

- (1) By submitting the application form, the participant bindingly declares his/her intention to participate in the DMY International Design Festival Berlin 2009 'Youngsters' Module.
- (2) Application does not guarantee effective participation in the event. DMY Berlin reserves the right not to accept applicants or products at the event. Application deadline is March 15, 2009. Following this date, a board of trustees named by the organiser will select the participants.

4. Schedules for construction, disassembly and deliveries

- (1) Construction and disassembly of the stand, as well as deliveries, are submitted to a strict schedule which participants will receive separately with the written participation confirmation. These schedules have to be respected at all costs.
- (2) It is strictly forbidden to disassemble the exhibition stands before the end of the exhibition. Disassembly of the stand is allowed only after the end of the exhibition. DMY Berlin is entitled to compensation claims should this not be respected.

5. Allocation of stands, makeup of stands

The surfaces will not be allocated uniformly. Depending on the project, DMY Berlin will allocate surfaces according to capacities, repertoire and the individual needs of the participant. The DMY Youngsters Module is part and parcel of the DMY International Design Festival Berlin and presents itself as an exhibition with a global concept. Organisation of the exhibition space lies with the organiser.

6. Building regulations, safety regulation

- (1) During construction and disassembly, and during the entire duration of the event, all legal accident prevention regulations and other safety regulations have to be respected.
- (2) The organiser's technical guidelines as well as information featured in the organiser's newsletters regarding the preparation and implementation of the event have to be respected.
- (3) The organiser is responsible for safety regulations regarding stand safety and fire control. All tasks requiring the use of open flames, welding, cutting, soldering and melting have to be submitted to the organiser and can only be carried out with permission.
- (4) During the exhibition's opening times, the stand has to be permanently occupied by personnel. The participant is personally responsible for the supervision of the stand during opening times and during the construction/disassembly. Therefore, each exhibitor is responsible for the security of his objects, especially in the case of theft.

7. Important information regarding construction

- (1) Regarding stand construction, the tasks performed by the organiser are limited to the installation of electricity in the stand and the setting up of partition walls and ceiling suspensions that have been previously booked by the participant. Further equipment such as power strips etc., have to be supplied by the participant himself/herself.
- (2) Depending on the position of the stand, ceiling height varies between 5 and 10 meters. Suspension material (steel cables/clamps/other) have to be provided by the participant. The suspension of objects is carried out by the organiser after being discussed individually with the participant.
- (3) The floor of the exhibition venue can be neither painted nor drilled. Adhesive tape has to be removed with all of its residue.
